PROJECT ALREADY UNDERTAKEN DURING THE YEAR 2021-2022:

1. WELFARE ACTIVITY OF OUR ORGANISATION:

(A) WELFARE OF THE AGED:

**TOUR PROGRAMME FOR THE AGED:** The Organisation arranged a tour Programme for the aged person this year. It conducted a tour to Gauhati with 30 aged people as its beneficiaries in the month of May 2021.

(B) WOMENS EMPOWERMENT & CHILD DEVELOPMENT:

With our limited source we have formed 30 nos of Self Help Group for the women in the rural areas. Some of the SHG's were given given training on Poultry & Succury farming while a few were given training on jute craft. Moreover we arranged for supply of nutritious foods for the young children of the poor families of the villages where the SHG's were formed.

(C) FREE HEALTH CHECK UP CAMP:

The NECE Dhubri Organized 3 nos of Free Health Check up Camp at Nilokhia, Dewaneralga and Paglarhat village during the period of 2019-2020 with the help of different NGO's located in the said area. Medicine are collected from the Medicine Company at a very cheap rate. During the camp period we have examined & treated about 310 nos patient and distributed free Medicine. Most of the weaker section are participated in the camp.

(D) NATIONAL YOUTH DAY:

Observed National Youth Day on 12<sup>th</sup> January 2020 at NECE main premises. More than 50 nos of youth participated in this occasion. Various programmes like lecture on Swami Vivekananda Art Competition, essay competition were organized.

(F) CULTURAL PROGRAMME:

The Organisation usually Organizes Cultural Show in connection with Festivals such as Bihu, IDD, Swaraswati Pujja and Vishwakarma Pujja etc. More than 4220 both male & female attended the progra
